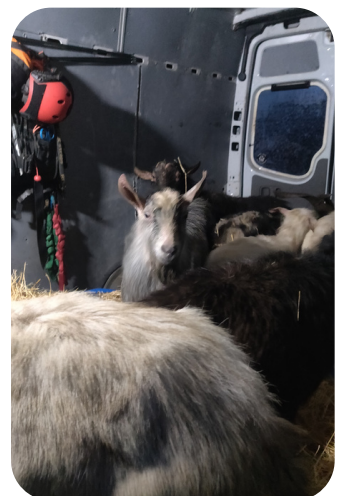
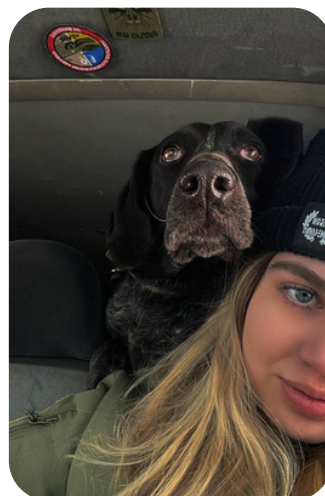

We spent **UAH 1 015 126.58(≈\$24,260)**. The remaining 23.42(≈\$0,5) will be put towards the next fundraiser for help

We used the funds raised for their intended purpose and have prepared a report for you. Scroll down to see that your help is making a difference!

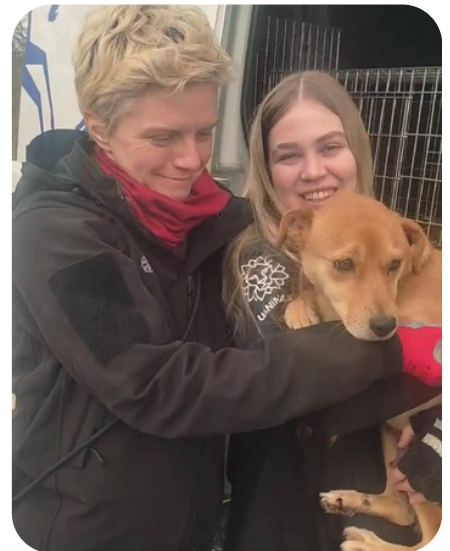
🚐 With the money raised, we went on 10 evacuation trips to the Donetsk, Zaporizhzhia, Kherson, and Kharkiv regions, where we rescued 245 animals. Most of them were cats, kittens, dogs, and puppies. But among the rescued animals were also two cows, a calf, two pigs, 19 goats and billy goats, a swan, and a chicken.



We covered the cost of fuel for the evacuation vehicles, as well as for the vehicle of volunteers who respond to calls, go to frontline areas, and help evacuate animals to safer places.

In addition, we covered the team's food and accommodation expenses, as well as the purchase of supplies, such as feed, hay, straw, diapers, carriers, and more.

🚚 We also transported 67 animals from clinics to shelters and new forever homes. Previously, we had evacuated them from towns and villages under ongoing enemy shelling. Thanks to medical care, love, and rehabilitation, they have recovered and are now being settled into better conditions.



In total, we spent **UAH 357,560.1 (~\$8,615)** on animal evacuation and transportation.

❤️🩹 In addition, the funds raised covered veterinary procedures for the evacuated animals — 22 cats and kittens and 23 dogs and puppies:

- We paid **UAH 30,739 (~\$740)** and **UAH 31,725.55 (~\$764)** for two surgeries for Filia, a dog rescued by volunteers from Kherson. The animal had the ball-shaped part of the femur removed from both sides. We also paid **UAH 3,176 (~\$76)** for a regular examination and painkiller injections;



- We paid for examinations, hospitalization, food, medical supplies, a complete blood count, a biochemical blood test, an ultrasound of the abdominal cavity, pelvic organs, and heart, tests for heartworm, injections, a test for plague, and surgery on the digestive system of the dog named Grey. The animal had been evacuated at the soldier's request. We spent **UAH 145,488.2 (~\$3,505)**;



- We paid **UAH 24,806 (~\$597)** for an examination, blood tests (complete blood count and biochemistry), a test for panleukopenia, an ultrasound of the abdominal organs, hematopoietic agents, hepatoprotective agents, antiemetics, as well as a blood transfusion for the cat named Mini. The animal had been evacuated from Beryslav in the Kherson region. Afterwards, Mini underwent a blood test and was prescribed antibiotics, antihistamines, antiemetics, bronchodilators, hepatoprotective agents, immunosuppressants, hormonal medications, analgesics and anesthetics, infusion solutions, vitamins, injections, ointments, and eye drops. The second bill was **UAH 32,615 (~\$785)**;



- We covered various veterinary procedures for 10 animals evacuated from the Zaporizhzhia and Donetsk regions. Specifically, hospitalization, examinations, ear and eye treatments, tests for viral diseases (immunodeficiency, leukemia, panleukopenia, calicivirus), blood collection and analysis, vaccinations, and veterinary passports for seven cats. Hospitalization, examination, parasite treatment, ear and eye care, and vaccination for a puppy. Hospitalization, examinations, parasite treatment, vaccinations, spaying/neutering, and post-operative suture care for two dogs. We spent **UAH 112,734 (~\$2,716)**;



- We covered hospitalization, examination, a smear test for babesiosis, tests for heartworm and parvovirus, a complete blood count, injections, catheterization, infusion therapy, medication administration, vaccination, spaying, suture care, and supportive care for Mania, a dog evacuated from the Dnipropetrovsk region. The total bill was **UAH 8,385 (~\$202)**;



- We paid **UAH 1,500 (~\$36)** for Kashtanka's spaying. The dog had been evacuated from Trudove in the Zaporizhzhia region;



- We covered examinations, tests, vaccinations, treatments, food, hospitalization, and blood tests for 5 puppies from Orikhiv, Zaporizhzhia Oblast. The total bill was **UAH 22,322 (~\$537)**;



- We covered the costs of boarding, food, and probiotics (for the puppies) for 17 dogs, 12 cats, and two puppies evacuated from the Donetsk, Zaporizhzhia, and Dnipropetrovsk regions. The total bill was **UAH 16,949 (~\$408)**;
- We covered the costs of various veterinary procedures for five animals evacuated from the Zaporizhzhia region at the soldiers' request. Specifically, tests for viral diseases, parasite treatments, vaccinations, spaying/neutering, and suture care for three cats; vaccinations and treatments for two dogs. The bill also included temporary care for 44 animals that had been evacuated earlier (21 cats, 23 dogs, and puppies). In total, we spent **UAH 62,647 (~\$1,509)**;



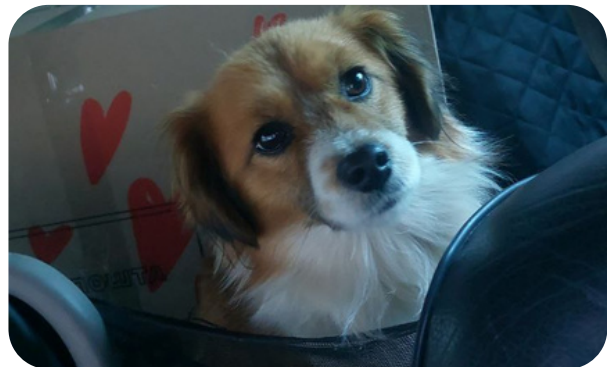
- We paid **UAH 13,915 (~\$335)** for temporary care, examinations, and food for 18 cats, seven dogs, and a puppy evacuated from the Donetsk, Zaporizhzhia, and Dnipropetrovsk regions;
- We paid **UAH 19,784 (~\$476)** for revaccination and antiparasitic medications for nine cats evacuated from Zaporizhzhia and Donetsk regions;



- We covered the costs of hospitalization, blood tests, ear and eye treatments, parasite treatments, smear tests for babesiosis and heartworm, vaccinations, antibiotics, and spaying for the dog and her puppy, evacuated from Orikhiv in the Zaporizhzhia region. In total, we spent **UAH 22,003 (~\$530)**;



- We covered the cost of hospitalization, examination, treatment, medical supplies, and injections for the dog named Lesia. The animal had been found by soldiers in the Donetsk region along with her puppy. The total bill was **UAH 29,800.50 (~\$718)**;

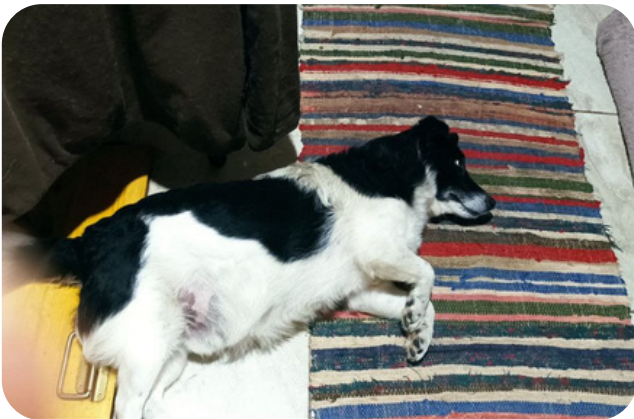


- We paid **UAH 792 (~\$19)** for examination, hospitalization, treatment, and vaccination for a dog cared for by a soldier in Zaporizhzhia Oblast;
- We paid **UAH 27,630 (~\$665)** for temporary care, examination, and food for 15 cats, seven dogs, and a puppy evacuated from the Donetsk, Zaporizhzhia, and Dnipropetrovsk regions.
- We paid for temporary care, food, and probiotics (for the puppies) for 18 dogs, 19 cats, and three puppies evacuated from the Donetsk, Zaporizhzhia, and Dnipropetrovsk regions. The total bill was **UAH 31,471 (~\$758)**.

- We covered the cost of an examination, vaccinations, and treatments for two puppies and a dog evacuated from the Zaporizhzhia region. The total bill was **UAH 2,612 (~\$62)**;



- We covered the cost of an examination, X-rays, an echocardiogram, and medication for Socrates, a dog evacuated from the Dnipropetrovsk region. The total bill was **UAH 1,632.50 (~\$39)**;



- We paid for hospitalization, food, and medications for the cat named Grafit from Huliaipole in the Zaporizhzhia region. We paid for hospitalization, food, spaying, and injections for the dog named Biliashka from Orikhiv in the Zaporizhzhia region. The total bill for the treatment of these animals was **UAH 4,830 (~\$116)**;



- We paid for hospitalization, food, post-operative care, supplies, suture care, and injections for Fialka, a cat evacuated from Kramatorsk in the Donetsk region. The total bill was **UAH 10,000 (≈\$240)**.



In total, we spent **UAH 657,566.57 (≈\$15,844)** on treating the evacuated animals.
