We spent **UAH 356,560 (≈\$8,612)**. The remaining UAH 2,230 (≈\$53) will be put towards the next fundraiser **for the evacuation and care of injured and sick animals, 12.0**

If animals could say thank you, they certainly would. For now, we'll say thank you. Thanks to your donations, we were able to transfer funds to purchase 300-liter field kitchens for two shelters. Thank you, friends.

One such kitchen allows you to cook hundreds of servings at once. Thus, cats and dogs will have warm meals on time, and the volunteers will have a little more time to simply be there and pet them instead of endlessly standing watch by the fire 🥰

Thanks to your donations, such a kitchen has been installed at the Sumy Society for the Protection of Animals shelter with over 500 dogs in care. We transferred **UAH 175,630 (~\$4,242)** to this shelter.



The new field kitchen is also already in use at the Kitskin Dim Mokri Nosy shelter in Poltava, which cares for 306 animals. We transferred **UAH 180,930 (~\$4,370)** to this shelter.

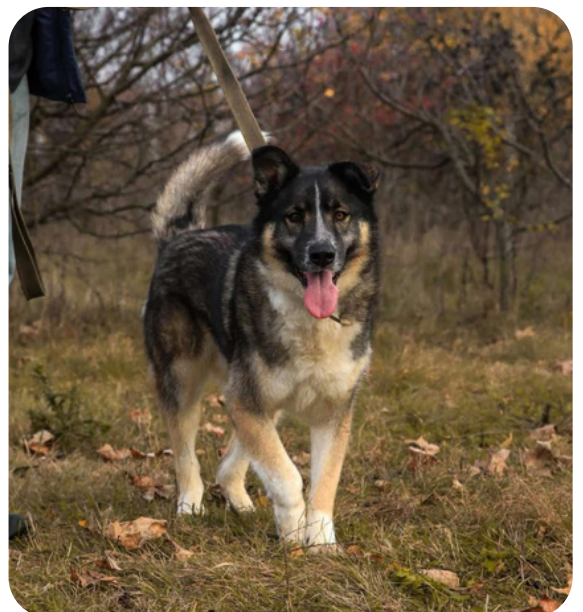


We'd like to tell you the stories of a few animals with you. Thanks to your donations, it will be easier to prepare food for them and for over 800 other animals.

🐶 **A dog named Bouquet being cared for at the Sumy Society for the Protection of Animals shelter**, had been found burned and nearly lifeless in the rubble after airstrikes in the Sumy region. Despite losing one eye and undergoing four months of difficult surgeries, he survived and is now learning to trust people again.



🐶 **A dog named Eugene** live at the same shelter. His previous family was about to euthanize him after a severe accident, as his chances of survival were almost nonexistent. Despite shattered paw bones and numerous fractures, he underwent complex surgeries, survived, and is now running again.



🐶 This is **a dog named Kesha**. Unfortunately, his owner was killed during a missile attack in Toretsk, Donetsk region. The dog was left on the street and survived in a pack with two other dogs. The UAnimals evacuation team rescued all three and brought them to the Kitskin Dim Mokri Nosy shelter.
